

VARIABLES IMPACTING BLUE CROSS COVERAGE FOR DENTAL IMPLANTS

By understanding these variables, you can better determine what kind of coverage you have for dental implants under your Blue Cross plan.

Plan Type: Different Blue Cross plans have varying levels of coverage for dental procedures. Some plans may offer no coverage for dental implants, while others may offer limited coverage

Reason for Implant: Dental implants are considered a major dental procedure. Coverage for implants may be more likely if they are deemed medically necessary.

Annual Maximums: Many Blue Cross dental plans have annual maximums, which is the total amount the plan will pay for covered services in a given year.

Pre-existing Conditions: Some Blue Cross plans may have exclusions for pre-existing conditions. If you were considering dental implants before you enrolled in your plan.

Out-of-Network Providers: If you choose to see a dentist who is out-of-network with Blue Cross, you may be responsible for a higher percentage of the cost of your dental implants.

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
